Admissions Criteria

- 2) Complete and return the application and non-refundable \$75 application fee, and a copy of the child's birth certificate.
- 3) If Registration paperwork is distributed after meeting with Sister, please complete and return with payment – include report cards.

International Student Grading Policy:

- If a student is deemed unable to adequately communicate in English, they will not receive letter grades on their report card.

To obtain an I-20:

- Students must be officially enrolled in school (Previously completed application, registration and payment received)
- Provide home address in US and family address abroad.
- Copy of Passport

Students with an I-20 status:

Are required to stay for the entire academic school year (August-June). Tuition is non-refundable.
